Key learnings

- Very surprising case from dr van Wijk from OLVG
- Myocardial infarction from septal branch occlusion
- Vanishing CTO
- Pseudoaneurysm of left main
- Reassuring late follow-up angio result

Key Learnings:

- Be aware of coronary spasm, especially in young women (and spontaneous dissections). In doubt, use nitro if no contraindication
- Check main stem at end of procedure
- In case of proximal pseudoaneurysm, consider pro's and con's for DES, covered stent or CABG, also with respect to late patency

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
